

EXPRESSION CITY SUMMER INTENSIVE 2023 MAIN STAGE PRODUCTION

- Students ages 14-19 are invited to audition for the cast placement of the Summer Intensive Main Stage Production of "Something Rotten".
- The show will be audition based. Only casted students are permitted to enroll for the intensive. A non-refundable of \$50 deposit is charged upon enrollment to cover student books & materials. Camp tuition is \$425.00 and will be drafted on 7/1/23. Classes start July 24th and end August 5th. Drop off will be 9:15am-9:30am and rehearsals will be 9:30am-3:30pm Monday-Friday.
- The rehearsals and the shows will be held at 1724a General George Patton Brentwood TN 37027 at Expression City Studio
- Students must wear comfortable clothing you can move in and closed toed shoes. Students will need to pack a lunch, snack, and bottled water. Performances will be Aug 4^{th} & 5^{th} .

- 1. Sing a memorized one-minute song selection of your choice. You can sing a-cappella or use an accompaniment recording.

- 4. This is your chance to "let your light shine" and show the directors what you can do! Be confident, be positive, and be yourself!

SHOW EXPECTATIONS AND AGREEMENT EXPECTATIONS

- 1. Once the show is cast. We will send you materials for the show. So that you can start practicing at home prior to summer intensive starting. This will help our 2-week intensive run smoothly.
- 2. Be ready to work ahead, both musically and dramatically.
- 3. Use rehearsal "down time" wisely—grab a friend and run some lines! Always be rehearsing at rehearsal!
- 4. Always behave in an appropriate manner. We have a no tolerance policy (see below)
- 5. All Cast must attend the entire 2 weeks of the intensive.
- 6. All music lyrics and speaking parts, and songs must be memorized by MONDAY, JULY 24TH. This script is difficult, and we have a lot of work to do! It will be much easier on you and the rest of the cast if your part is memorized. We will post parts on the private Facebook as soon as possible to give you the tools to have this done. Materials from the script will be the ONLY content performed for our show "Something Rotten". Improving or adding lines or lyrics will NOT be prohibited.
- 7. Cast members must understand that if your behavior or attitude is deemed unproductive or disrespectful to the director and other cast or crew members, you will be subject to dismissal.
- 8. All cast members are expected to arrive and depart on time. Showing up late not only hurts you, but also disrupts the rehearsal process.
